- Recognize barriers to engagement for BME communities
- Increase knowledge on drug use and ethnicity

Learning Outcomes

- Be aware of relevant legislation that impacts on service delivery to communities
- Understand the diversity of communities
- Reflect on personal assumptions and stereotypes
- Be aware of differences in drug use in diverse communities
- Be aware of steps required to deliver a culturally competent service
